- Stratford Campus – close to the London 2012 Olympic Stadium

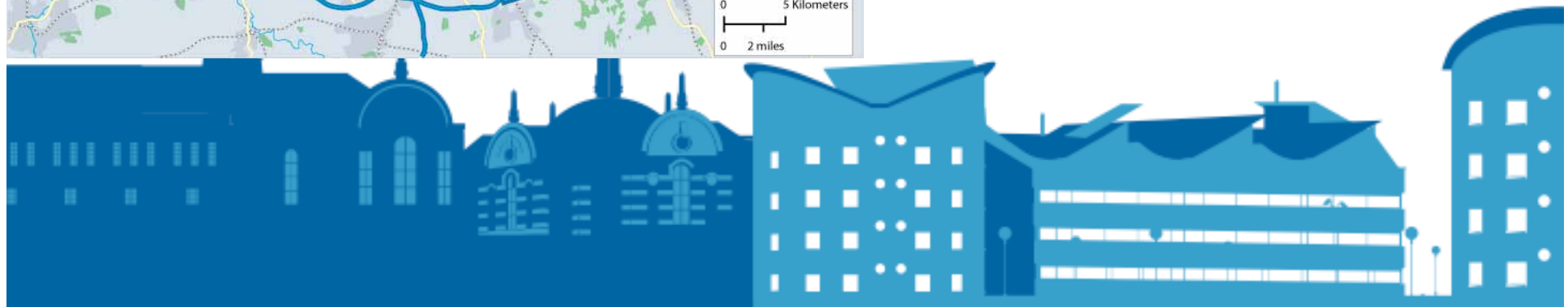
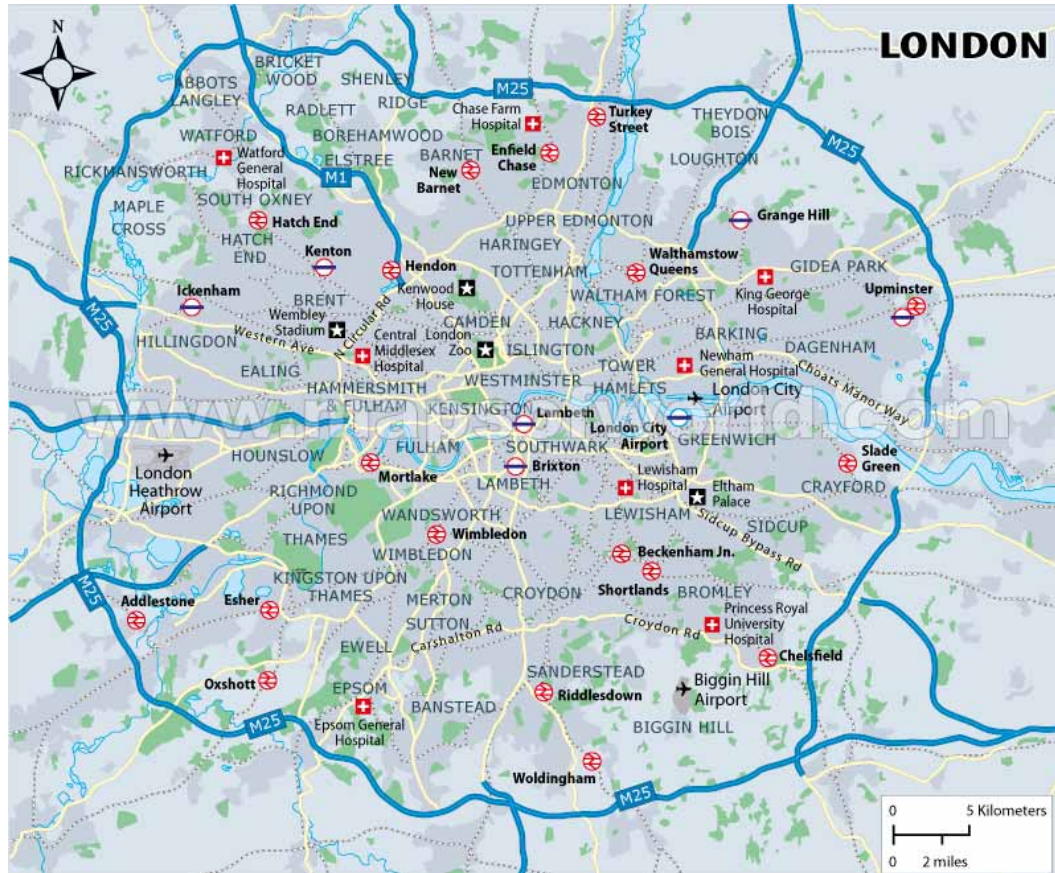


Why UEL?

Fees & Scholarships

- Fees vary per programme
- Examples: £9900 (e.g. MA Acting) - £11130 (MA Architecture)
- Programmes are typically 10 months in duration
- So: MA Acting £990 per month
- MA Architecture £1130 per month
- £750 for students with 50% - 60% in Undergraduate degree
- £2000 for students with 60% + in undergraduate degree
- Early payment discount of 5% also applies



Fees & Scholarships

- Scholarships available to Brazilian students
- Fees can be paid in instalments
- Fee waivers and School scholarships available
