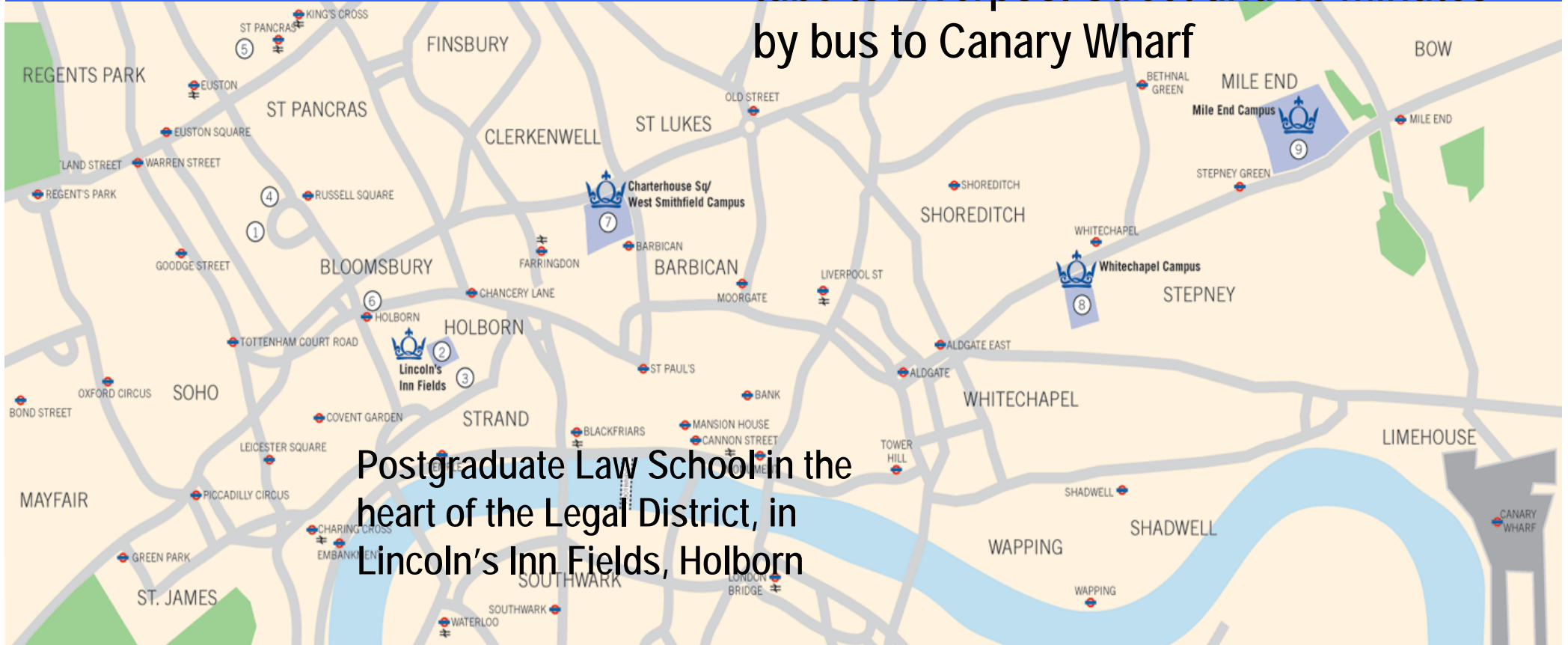

# Entry Requirements –LLM and most PG Law Masters

We consider every application on a case by case basis

For entry onto the LLM, Brazilian students should normally have achieved minimum **GPA of 7.5 in the Licenciatura or Bacharel** degree from a recognised Brazilian University.

English –we accept **ALL** of the following –only one is necessary –minimum entry reqs:

IELTS 7.0

TOEFL 610 (TWE 5)

CBTOEFL 263 (TWE 5)

IBTOEFL 100 (writing 24/30)

WELT BBB

Cambridge Advanced English (A) or Cambridge Proficiency English (B)



## Finances
